Annual Report 2021-2022

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell, SGBMP in fact, is conceived as a mechanism to build and ensure a quality culture in the functioning of the College. The primary aim of IQAC is to develop a system for conscious, consistent and catalytic action to improve the academic and administrative performance of the institution. During the academic year 2021-22, the IQAC has taken several measures to enhance the quality culture in the curricular, co-curricular, extra-curricular, research and extension, infrastructural facilities, and the Best Practices of the College.

Curricular Activities
